Dietrich Kastens

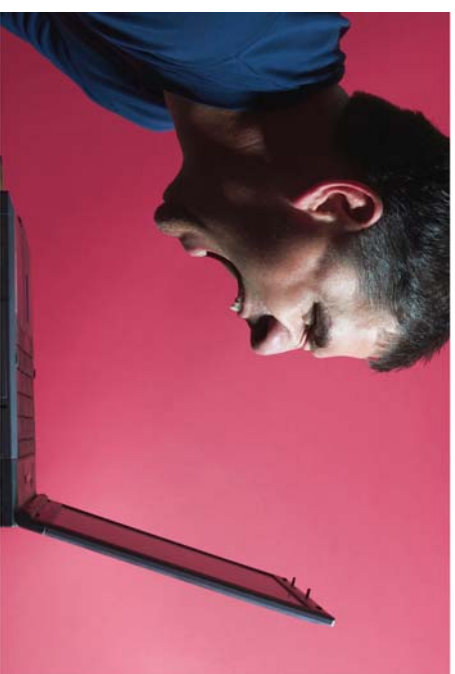
